# Small UAS Registration

This process is web based, free of charge, and not done at point-of-purchase.

1. Does your UA weigh between 0.55 pounds and 55 pounds?
2. Are you over 13 years of age? (Children under 13 must fly under their parent’s registration.)
3. Have you completed the mandatory “education component?”
4. If you currently own one or more small UAS and wish to provide the serial numbers, please do so below. You are not required to mark your UA with a registration number if you provide the serial numbers below. If you do not provide these numbers, you must permanently mark all UAs with your assigned registration number in a location that is readily accessible and legible upon close inspection.

5. Provide your name and street address. Phone number and email are optional.

NOTE: Your information will be available on the FAA database only to law enforcement “or other authorities” for the purposes of confirming your registration status.

*Failure to comply with registration requirements will result in penalty that is distinct from those related to manned aviation.*
